In the Gospel according to Mark, we read about how Jesus heals a man with a demon (Chapter 5). Later on, this man let Jesus know that he wanted to follow him, however, our Lord replied to him,

*“.. Go home to thy friends, and **tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee, and hath had compassion on thee [emphasis added]**” (Mark 5:19).*
