The result was that we recorded six lessons on Moral Issues and three short videos in the Why God? series. Those lessons will be published soon. We also launched social media accounts for the School. We also visited a congregation here in Panama recently, provided some of the Spanish invitation cards (available through store.wvbs.org), and let the brethren know what the School offers, and many of them marveled as they were getting to know of the great resources we have available. Lord willing, we will also start doing some short videos and podcasts based on the book “Divine Relationships” by Winford Claiborne, per collaboration with International Gospel Hour. The book of Acts is our next course and translation work is in progress, and hopefully will be recorded in a couple of months. Moving to Texas is still in the plans, and we already contacted an immigration lawyer to help us with this process. Please pray that we find an expedited and smooth way to get this done as we put everything in God’s hands.

Thanks be to God the Spanish Bible School is not just an idea but a reality, and this is possible because of God and all of you who support this work.
