The apostle Paul urged the church in Corinth: *"that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye **be perfectly joined together** in the same mind and in the same judgment"* (1 Corinthians 1:10, KJV). All confirmed this simple truth: the work of the Lord we are blessed to do is **both needed and deeply appreciated** throughout the body of Christ. And this encouragement is not only in the US, but read what a gentleman in Argentina wrote:
