REACHING BEYOND BORDERS

There's a special joy in seeing the Gospel cross not only cities and countries but also languages and cultures. As Corrie Ten Boom, a Holocaust survivor, once said, "Never be afraid to trust an unknown future to a known God." What a wonderful truth for those of us blessed to work in His kingdom!

This past month, we were privileged to visit our brethren in **Maryland**, **USA**, where we conducted a **Congregational Evangelism** training. Once again, we joined Rob Whitacre and his family, who trained the English-speaking group, while we taught the Spanish-speaking congregation—with more than **170** in attendance for **worship**. It is not common to find Hispanic congregations of that size, and we rejoiced in preaching the truth of the Gospel and sharing the School's resources with them. Their enthusiasm and desire to grow in the Lord were deeply encouraging—a reminder that the seed of the Gospel continues to bear fruit wherever it is sown. One attendee told us, *"Thank you so much for clarifying so many questions I had through such simple but powerful lessons!"*

Our online work continues to reach far beyond what we could imagine. Although places like **Canada**, **Belgium**, **the United Kingdom**, and **Germany** may not sound "Hispanic," we keep receiving messages from souls there who want to study God's Word in Spanish. It's humbling to see how the Lord uses technology to reach hearts we might never meet in person but can still help come to know Him.

We've also been busy releasing new materials recorded throughout this year—What Is Apologetics?, Was I Born a Sinner?, and our in-depth course on the Epistle to the Ephesians, featuring 18 video lessons and more than 100 pages of study notes. Each of these resources is designed to strengthen faith, encourage deeper study, and equip others to share the truth of Christ with confidence and love, and available through our websites buscandolaverdad.org and escuelabiblicaenlinea.org.
